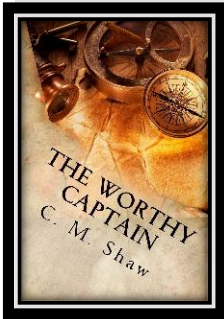

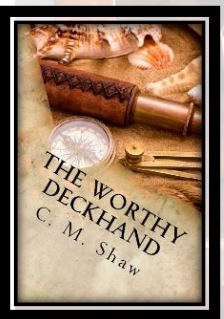
### 1-THE WORTHY CAPTAIN

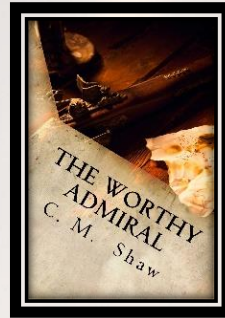
### 2-THE WORTHY DECKHAND

Fairbury's deckhands are being tempted, the old worthy captain must determine who he deems is worthy to pass on the captaincy of his ship.

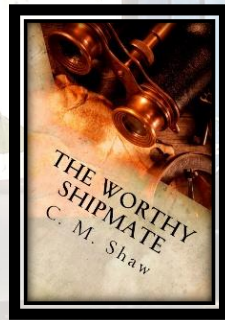
### 3-THE WORTHY ADMIRAL
