

About Inanovate, Inc.

Inanovate, Inc, is an early stage life science company developing diagnostic tests for cancer, using a patented technology platform called the Bio-ID. The Bio-ID enables the accurate identification, validation and analysis of multiple different blood based biomarkers in one low-cost easy to use test. The first test under development on the Bio-ID is a test to identify false positive results from a screening mammogram; aimed at reducing unnecessary follow up imaging procedures and biopsies, that are both costly and stress inducing for patients. Supplementing this initial indication is a test to monitor the progress of breast cancer patients through therapy and beyond; aimed at identifying a recurrence event in its earliest stage, when it may be more effectively treated and cured. Longer term, Inanovate plans to continue to expand the Bio-ID's utility across additional cancer indications and selected autoimmune diseases. Inanovate's ultimate goal is to enable early and accurate diagnosis and monitoring of all cancer types through low-cost accessible blood tests.

South Dakota Equity Partners is comprised of seasoned institutional investors, including banks, corporations, university foundations, economic development corporations, family offices and individuals. It was created as the result of an initiative started in 2015 by the South Dakota Governor's Office of Economic Development at Gov.
