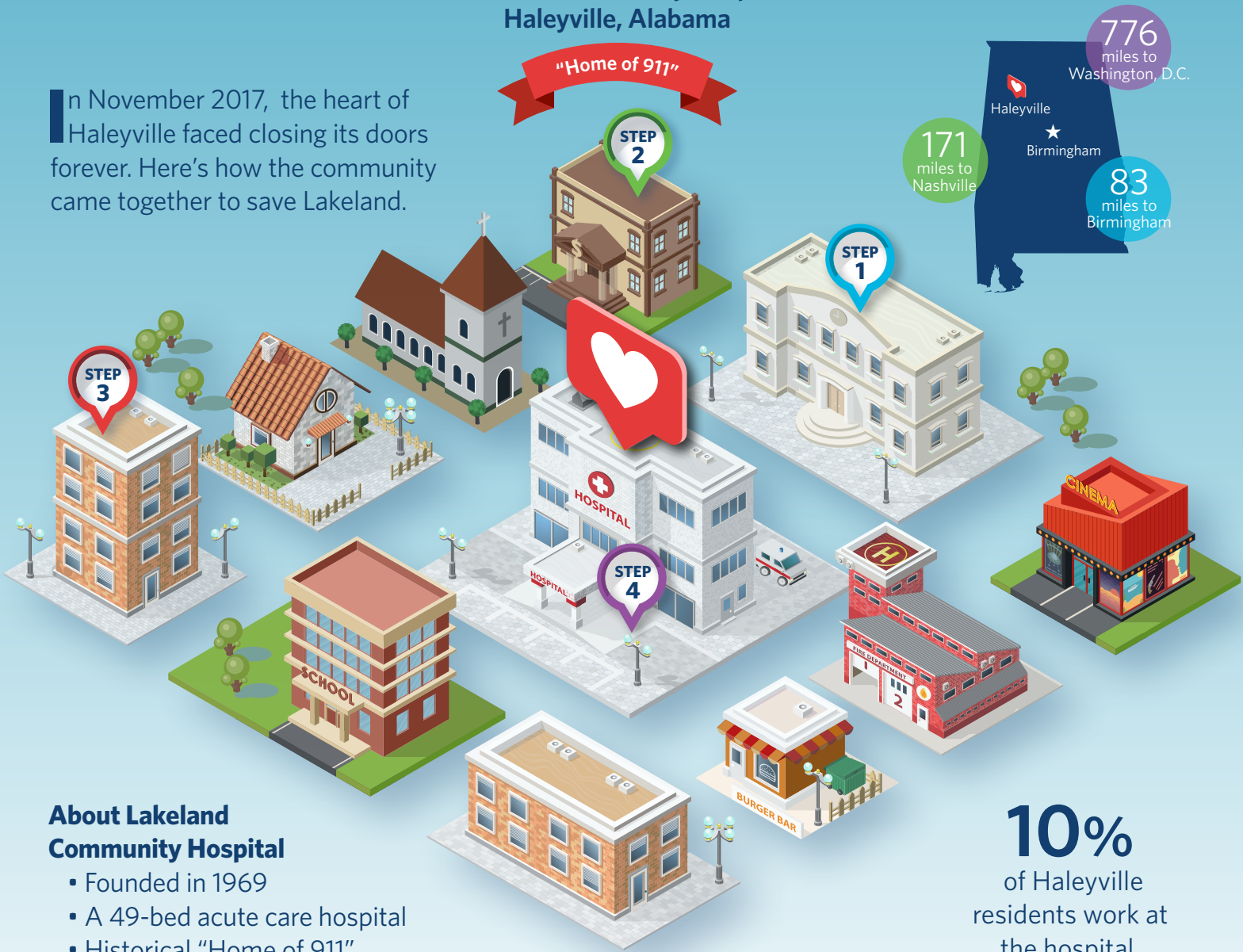


A ROADMAP TO SAVING A COMMUNITY HOSPITAL

About Lakeland Community Hospital

STEP 1

Recruited Local Support:

The mayor, city council, community leaders, hospital administrators, and employees formed the Haleyville Healthcare Authority.

STEP 2

Found Investors and Hospital Management:

With help from new hospital management and vendors, the city council devised a recovery plan that called for a sales tax increase, new services, and an all-hands-in effort from hospital staff.

STEP 3

Developed a Long-Term Strategy:

MEDHOST provided Lakeland's central business office services and designed a process for financial recovery, including a payment plan for outstanding debt.

STEP 4

Persisted:

An unwavering commitment from staff, community leaders, and rural healthcare advocates kept Lakeland Community Hospital's doors open. More than a year later, Lakeland is adding patient services and building more efficiency into its hospital.
