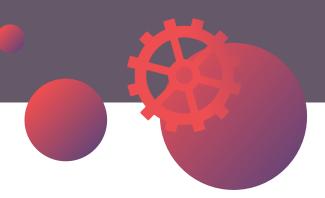
PoC at Perfectial

Scope, objectives, and success criteria

Main features validation
