**St. Johns GOP's Christmas Message to the Chairs of the
Republican Party of Florida's County Executive Committees**

Dear REC Chairs,

God Bless America and Merry Christmas to you and your family from St. Johns GOP!

We are Bill White and Leopold Roy, writing on behalf of Manuel P. Asensio, founder and chairman of the St. Johns Republican Presidential Executive Committee. We are assisting Manuel in writing his second book titled *"Sold Short: Uncovering Deception in America's Two-Party Government."* His first book is titled *"Sold Short: Uncovering Deception in the Markets."*

We are also assisting Manuel in addressing critical matters affecting the Republican Party's leadership and its commitment to constitutional governance. Our work with the members of the Republican National Executive Committee and the officers of the Republican National Committee (RNC) aligns with the World Intellectual Property Organization's (WIPO) October 8, 2024, decision and order in Manuel's favor. This order created the Republican Party's only official GOP county organization dedicated to a uniquely America First/MAGA federal judicial policy.

Manuel prevailed in his fight by showing the WIPO that the actions and policies of certain members of the Republican Party of Florida (RPOF) and RNC conflicted with the interests and priorities of the America First/MAGA members of the Republican Party, as well as those of President Donald J. Trump who is the GOP political and executive leader. These actions undermine trust within the GOP and risk compromising the GOP's foundational principles.

We seek to emphasize that this responsibility falls not only on the RPOF and RNC staff but particularly on Florida's state committeemen and state committeewomen, who are charged with faithfully representing us at the RNC's Executive Committee. These individuals, alongside Governor Ron DeSantis, bear a critical duty to ensure Florida's voice is heard by Republicans nationwide and to act in the best interests of the party and its members. This is what Asensio and MAGA Republicans won with St. Johns GOP's landmark WIPO victory.

The WIPO victory specifically gives America First/MAGA Republicans the power to confront Leonard Leo and the Federalist Society, who have proven to be among America's greatest traitors to the Constitution. Leo has managed to sell the Federalist brand to conservatives. Yet it was corrupt Federalist politicians who executed their "midnight judges" scheme and who fabricated the 1803 *Marbury v. Madison* ruling, which entrenched joint political and judicial supremacy into American government at the expense of the Constitution and people's rights and authority. Leo perpetuated this betrayal by burying the Judicial Conduct Act of 1980, which was created to discipline federal judges. This law could have been the cornerstone of President Ronald Reagan's vision for vacating *Roe v. Wade* as an illegal judicial act and restoring judicial accountability in America during his term.

Leo's actions have also targeted President Trump, undermining him at critical moments. This began during Trump's 2016 campaign, continued throughout his presidency with judicially driven obstacles such as 50 universal injunctions against his policies, and culminated in the post-2020 presidential

election litigation where Leo played a key role in manipulating and deceiving Vice President Mike Pence into unilaterally and arbitrarily certifying the constitutionality of the 2020 presidential election.

Given these concerns, we urge you, as leaders of the Republican Party of Florida, to join Asensio and the St. Johns GOP to act decisively on these issues:

1. **Regulate the Federalist Society's Influence within the RNC:** Leonard Leo and the Federalist Society have never confronted organized federal judicial corruption. In fact, over its forty-two-year history, the Federalist Society has done the exact opposite—profited from acquiescing to judicial corruption.

The Federalist idea of acquiescing to judicial corruption reflects a deeper, systemic failure to confront the misuse of judicial power. It suggests not only passive tolerance but also active complicity by politicians and judges who profit from judicial corruption under the flag of avoiding conflict over upholding constitutional principles. 2. **Eliminate Organized Federal Judicial Corruption at the U.S. Judicial Conference:** We assisted Asensio in his investigation of the U.S. Judicial Conference's illicit national policymaking and his prosecution of the nation's first criminal indifference to civil rights case against the presiding officer of the U.S. Judicial Conference. This action, known as the DRE case, targets federal judges' malicious takeover of people's due process and equal protection rights for the deliberate purpose of taking control of American religious and family liberty.
3. **Reversing Pence's Unlawful and Unconstitutional Verification:** Formally address the misconduct of William "Bill" Barr, J. Michael Luttig, and Richard Cullen regarding Pence's decision to violate, abandon, and disregard the lawful 5-5-5 resolution of the constitutionality of the 2020 presidential election. Pence unlawfully assumed unilateral authority to certify the constitutionality of election results—betraying the Constitution and the will of the American people.
4. **Transparency and Accountability:** Advance St. Johns GOP's reforms to address structural and ideological challenges within the federal judiciary that threaten constitutional governance. This aligns with our work with the RNC to rectify actions taken by RPOF leadership, including Governor Ron DeSantis and RNC General Counsel John Hammond, that appear to deviate from party rules and create unnecessary divisions.

First, of course, we must jointly reinforce the role of St. Johns GOP and the RPOF's executive committees in federal judiciary policymaking as the foundation of the Republican Party. This is critical to ensure that the GOP remains committed to its mission and constitutional principles.
