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17	The Health Officer of the County of Sacramento issued an order dated March 19, 2020,
18	under authority of California Health and Safety Code §§101040, 101085, and 120175, directing a
19	general shelter-in-place order as specified therein.
20	To immediately address the Health Officer's order, and to provide maximum protection
21	for the health and wellbeing to all people served by this Court, including court personnel, and
22	pursuant to the authority provided under California Government Code Section 68115 and as
23	granted in the March 17, 2020 order of Chief Justice Tani G. Cantil-Sakauye, Chair of the
24	Judicial Council of California,
25	This Court ORDERS AS FOLLOWS:
26	1. From March 20, 2020 to March 30, 2020, inclusive, the Presiding Judge has
27	declared those days to be court holidays for all purposes, except for the limited emergency
28	matters expressly enumerated below which may be addressed during such timeframe.

1	2. All courthouses and courtrooms are closed for judicial business, except for the
2	following matters, and only through the special procedures announced by the Court:
3	a. Ex parte requests for civil harassment temporary restraining orders, domestic
4	violence restraining orders, gun violence restraining orders, and emergency ex
5	parte lockout proceedings in unlawful detainer;
6	b. Emergency Petitions for Temporary Conservatorship
7	c. Emergency Petitions for Temporary Guardianship
8	d. Search Warrants, Emergency Protective Orders, and bail setting
9	e. Juvenile Temporary Restraining Orders and other Emergency Juvenile Orders
10	f. Family Emergency Temporary Restraining Orders
11	g. Emergency writs regarding COVID-19 emergency measures
12	h. Emergency Writs of Habeas Corpus regarding medical quarantines
13	3. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN THAT ALL CRIMINAL AND CIVIL
14	MATTERS NOT EXPRESSLY LISTED IN PARAGRAPH 2 ARE SUSPENDED UNTIL
15	FURTHER ORDER OF THIS COURT.
16	4. To the extent the directives and declarations set forth in this Order differ with the
17	Court's prior Order for Implementation of Emergency Relief, issued March 17, 2020, this Order
18	controls.
19	5. The Court shall issue further orders and notices regarding the procedures and
20	processes for bringing the matters enumerated in Paragraph 2 before the Court.
21	THIS ORDER IS EFFECTIVE IMMEDIATELY.
22	THIS ORDER MAY BE AMENDED AS CIRCUMSTANCES REQUIRE.
