The National Automobile Museum (The Harrah Collection) has a "Wow!" factor you don't often find in a museum. You'll see more than 200 eye-popping cars with authentic street scenes and sounds. The facades bring displays to life; a Blacksmith Shop here, a movie theatre there, with artifacts from each era. Audio tours in English and Spanish that let you explore the museum at your own pace.




